North Carolina law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address, job title or profession and name of employer or employer's specific field for each individual whose contributions aggregate is in excess of \$50.00 in an election (defined as the period beginning the day after the general election up to and including the primary and the period beginning the day after the primary up to and including the general election).

Did You Know?

- Unlike individual contributions to candidates, BUILD-PAC contributions are directly tied to the housing industry.
 Candidates therefore recognize the importance of our industry and want our support.
- BUILD-PAC contributions support political committees of candidates for statewide office, the NC General Assembly, judicial office, and local office.
- BUILD-PAC is non-partisan. We support candidates who support housing.



In the 2016 general election, BUILD-PAC participated in 48 NC Senate races and won 47 (98%). In the NC House, BUILD-PAC participated in 102 races and won 98 (96%).



- Exempted builder/developer properties from paying property taxes for improvements to real property.
- 2. Lobbied successfully for sales tax on labor exemption for new construction and remodeling.
- Enacted law that local governments cannot force inspections that are not required by the North Carolina Building Code.
- 4. Repealed authority for local governments to mandate design and aesthetic controls
- 5. Clarified that minor repairs do not require a state building permit.
